

Ontario Soybean Variety Trials 2022 - Locations and Directions

MG00 Early (2200) New Liskeard Agricultural Research Station

From highway 11, turn onto Armstrong ST. Towards highway 65
Continue on Armstrong St, at the lights you can turn left and go into the field at an entrance by the Hybrid Popular plantation or by going straight through the lights
A little over 250 m past the Hwy 65 lights is another field entrance, to the left
This gravel access road will curve to the right, then to the left.

The trial will have signage for the day of the sponsors visit.

MG00 (2400) Arthur (Belwood)

From the town of Arthur follow Hwy 109 (hwy 9) east to County Rd. 16 turn Right (south). Plot is located down the lane of the second house of the left. Follow lane all the way back around the bend to where the lane ends. Plot is on the right hand side. It will be signed at the road.

MG00 (2400) Dundalk

Take Hwy 89 east towards Shelburne, after 5 Line you will pass a bush. Right after the bush on the left hand side there is a lane with bins down it. Plot is on right hand side. It will be signed at the road.

MG00 (2400) & MG0 (2600) Elora

GPS at station entrance: 43.642019, -80.403829

GPS at plot location: 43.644522, -80.400715

The field is located directly across (northeast) from the station entrance. Follow the grass laneway across the road from the station, and travel about 370 m to the bottom corner of the field. From the bottom corner of the field, the MG0 and MG00 Roundup Ready Trials are located about 5 m in from the grass lane and the MG0 Conventional Trial is located approximately 40 m southwest towards the station building. Signs will be present.

MG0 (2600) Ottawa

All directions start from the intersection of Fisher Avenue and McCooey Lane

- You will see fields all around a set of lights
- From the lights head West into the farm

Roundup Ready (45.37413 -75.7286)

- Head West from the intersection of Fisher Avenue and McCooey Lane
- Take the first right on the gravel road
- Go around the bend and up the hill passed the small green shed
- You will come to a field of clover followed by some ornamental shrubs, you should see signage for the Roundup Ready trial on the right on the hillside
- It is the only trial in the field
- If you come to the brown shed you've gone too far, turn right and head North, you will be on the hill above the trial.

Conventional (45.37193 -75.73141)

- Head West from the intersection of Fisher Avenue and McCooey Lane
- Stay on McCooey Lane until the top of the hill
- After the last field before the trees turn right and drive North between the trees and field
- The trial is in the third field you come to adjacent to the tree line.

Notes:

- Google Maps likely won't take you into the farm unless you are searching Walking/Cycling directions
- Gates into the farm are locked at night and on weekends, if you need to visit the fields on the weekend I suggest parking by the Tim Horton's on Merivale road and crossing on foot into the farm.

MG0 (2600) Port Hope

From the 401, take (exit 456) and head North. It will be signed at the road. Turn right on County 2 Rd. It'll be the first road you come to. Plot is at 7th house on the left also a Pickseed testing farm. Follow lane back to last red shed on right. Plot is behind red shed on the right. It will be signed at road.

GPS: 43.970904°, -78.364025°

MG0 (2600) Brussels (Walton)

From Exeter take Hwy 4 north to Kippen Rd. Follow Kippen Rd. through Seaforth to Blyth Rd. Turn left onto Blyth Rd, then turn right on to Brussels Line. Take first left onto Walton Rd. Plot is on first farm on the left. Take the lane back behind barns. It will be signed at the road.

MG1 (2800) Winchester

12088 Baker Road, Winchester

If coming from the 401:

- Get on ON-401 E
- Follow ON-401 E to Route 31 in South Dundas.
- Take exit 750 for County Road 31 toward Morrisburg/Winchester
- Turn left (N) onto Route 31 (signs for County Road 31/Winchester/Ottawa)

19.6 km

- Turn left (W) onto Baker Rd. Research Station building will be on the left. Soybean plots will be on the north side of the road, before you reach the Research Station building.

1.1 km

If coming from 416:

- Take Exit 34 to Kemptville from 416.
- Turn left (E) onto County Rd 43 (signs for County Road 43)

21.8 km

- Turn right (S) onto Route 31/County Rd 43 E (signs for County Road 31/Morrisburg/Chesterville)
- Continue to follow Route 31

5.4 km

- Turn right (W) onto Baker Rd. Research Station building will be on the left. Soybean plots will be on the north side of the road, before you reach the Research Station building.

1.1 km

Entrance to Field:

The research station main building is at 12088 Baker Road, on the south side of Baker Road. The field containing the soybean research plots is on the north side of the road, east of 12088 Baker Road. There is a field entrance. When you are in the field entrance, turn left, going towards the evergreen fence row. The soybean plots will be in the range closest to the evergreen fence row. Signs will be posted.

MG1 (2800) Exeter

2800 HU Conventional and Roundup Ready (Huron Research Station). Location - southwest of Exeter at 70257 Airport Line. Trials are located in the 13th Range from the front of the farm on south side (S13). Follow the signs from middle laneway of Research Station. The GPS coordinates of plots are 43.3145848, -81.5088587.

MG1 (2800) St. Marys

Farm of Mr. Alex Gibson

GPS at driveway entrance: 43.3328615, -81.1763088

GPS of field entrance: 43.3328707, -81.1766727

Please proceed slowly down the driveway past the house, garage and barn, approximately 160m. The entrance to the field will be on your right (south). The plots begin 90m in from the barnyard, and the bottom of the field is to the west, towards the road. The MG1 Roundup Ready Trial is the first test you approach, and the MG1 Conventional trial is roughly 40m south of the MG1 Roundup Ready Trial. Signs will be present.

MG1 (2800) Woodstock

GPS at station entrance: 43.144305, -80.786039

GPS at plot location: 43.142702, -80.7956678

Take the gravel laneway opposite from the station entrance from 11th Line. Follow the laneway approximately 2 km through a series of L-bends. The Trials are in the field on your left after passing the tree line. The MG1 Roundup Ready Trial is the first trial you see, while the MG1 Conventional Trial is located approximately 40m further west. Signs will be present. The entrance to the Woodstock Research Station is gated. The gate should be open most days during station hours (9:00 am to 3:00 pm; Monday to Friday). A combination code to the gate will be e-mailed out prior to the start of the self-guided tour in September.

MG2E (3100) Talbotville (Fingal)

Take 401 to Colonel Talbot (4) South Exit. Head South through Talbotville to Sunset Dr. From Sunset Dr. turn right onto Fingal Line. From Fingal Line turn left onto Lyle Rd. Turn right onto Bush Line. Plot is right before a big bush on the right. It will be signed at the road.

MG2E (3100) Inwood

Take Exit 117 for County Road 20/Orford Rd from the 401. Turn north onto Orford Rd/ Chatham-Kent County Rd 20. Turn right onto Selton Line/County Rd 18. Turn Right onto Chatham-Kent County Rd 2. Turn left onto W Bothwell Rd/Chatham-Kent County Rd 16. Turn left onto Main Line/Chatham-Kent County Rd 16. Turn right onto Tower Rd/Chatham-Kent County Rd 16/County Rd 17. Continue onto Cairo Rd/Lambton County Rd 79 N. Turn left onto Aberfeldy Line. Turn right onto Little Ireland Rd. The farm will be located on the right side. Turn into the second driveway and progress past the sheds and barn and onto the back lane way. The plots will be located towards the back of the field and OSACC material is located closest to the road.

MG2E (3100) Palmyra

When driving down Highway three from Blenheim, the lane way will be on the right. Enter the Lane way and go past the house, barns and silos. As you progress down the back lane way, the site location is on the right. The OSACC material is located nearest to the lane way.

MG2E (3100) Ridgetown

Come to campus as normal and progress to the plots behind the main drive sheds. Once going over the tracks turn right at the next stop sign. Continue down the lane way until it dead-ends. The field is located directly in front of where the lane ends.

MG2L (3400) Chatham

Located just after Country Market Garden when leaving Chatham (7346 Riverview Line, Chatham, ON N7M 5J5)

When coming down Riverview line from Chatham turn left into the lane way just after the Country Market Garden. Continue a short distance down the laneway until our plots appear in the field on the right side. The trials are stacked in three tiers and the OSACC trials are all located in the first tier.

MG2L (3400) Merlin

Take exit 90 for ON-40/Communication Rd toward Chatham/Chatham-Kent County Rd 11/Blenheim. Turn onto Communication Rd/ON-40 S towards Blenheim. Turn right onto Cundle Line. Turn left onto Charing Cross Rd/Chatham-Kent County Rd 10. Turn right at the 1st cross street onto Middle Line/Chatham-Kent County Rd 8. Turn left onto Drake Rd. Once progressing down the driveway make a left at the barn, continue past the horses, and follow the laneway as it veers to the right. The plots will be located on the right side of the laneway as it ends.
